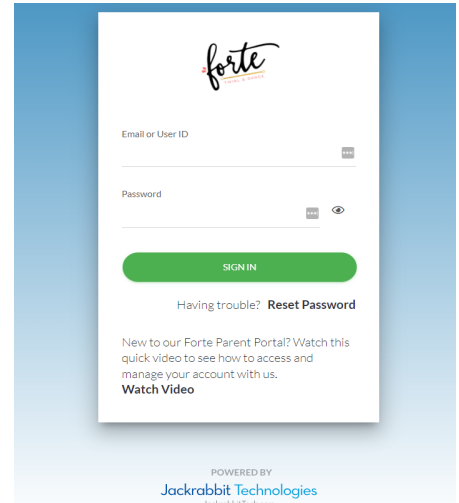

Billing

Tuition is due on the first of each month. Tuition will be automatically drafted from accounts on the first of each month. Drafts can be setup with a debit card, credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover) or bank account in the Parent Portal. No cash or check payments are accepted. A \$15 late fee is automatically charged to accounts not paid in full by the fifth of the month. Tuition is non-refundable.

Class Dress Code

Coming to class properly dressed is a requirement of baton, acro or dance class. At Forte, our dress code is designed so teachers can see the athlete's body lines, including posture, arms, legs and feet. In addition, the appropriate practice clothing, shoes and grooming ensure a safe environment for athletes. Please review the specific dress code for each class below. Any student not following the dress code will be asked to sit out.

Where do I purchase attire for my athlete?

At this time, Forte is not selling merchandise in-studio. We recommend purchasing athletic dance wear online or from any athletic store you like - Target has cute athletic gear for children! For jazz dance shoes (baton classes) and ballet shoes (ballet classes) that are required in class, we do not mandate a specific brand. Please be sure to double check sizing information before you order, as jazz/ballet shoes are sized differently from regular shoes!

When your child comes to class, please be sure their shoes, bags, water bottles, jackets, batons etc. are labeled with their name! Batons are available for use in-studio during class.

Attire for Ages 3 to 5 Years

Itty Bitty Ballet

Any color leotard. Tutus, skirts, or form-fitting jazz shorts may be worn over. Tights are not required, but can be worn if desired. Ballet flats (shoes) required. Hair must be pulled out of face and up in a bun.

Twirl and Tumble

Any color or style top, jazz shorts, leotard, tutus, etc. No baggy t-shirt or pants. Jazz dance shoe required. Hair must be pulled off face and up in a bun, braid or ponytail.

Attire for Ages 6 and Up

Ballet

Any color leotard with pink tights. Ballet skirt may be worn over if desired (no tutus). Canvas-sole ballet shoes required (any color/style). Hair must be pulled out of face and up in a bun.

Face masks recommended

Students are recommended to wear a mask upon entering and exiting the studio. 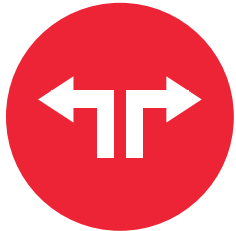
What to bring

We ask that students come to class fully prepared and dressed. No outside food or drink (other than water) is allowed. Students may bring a water bottle, their baton (if they have a personal one) and a small bag with their shoes if needed.



Hand sanitizer encouraged

Hand sanitizer is provided by Forte Twirl and Dance Studio. Students are recommended to use hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the studio.



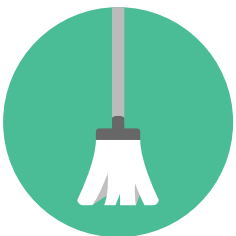
Social distancing

All students are asked to maintain distance in the lobby and the studio. We will work to maintain distance between students during classes.



Lobby is closed

In order to comply with capacity guidelines, the studio's lobby is currently closed. We ask that parents wait outside with your student until the instructor comes to the door to let the next class into the studio. Once class concludes, students can be picked up from the front door.



Enhanced studio and equipment cleaning

All batons and mats are sanitized between classes. Comprehensive cleaning and sanitization is performed daily to make sure Forte Twirl and Dance Studio is in compliance with CDC guidelines.
